

Getting Indexed By Google – The Simple way

These steps work for me. Usually I get indexed up to four days but it can take up to two weeks. It is suitable for **new sites**.

I had so many mistakes with my first site that it took me 7 months to get indexed. It is so easy to do the right things; all it takes is that **You Just Have To Know How To Do It**.

The following steps are very **easy** and can be implemented by **everyone**, NO special skills or software or services are required.

Make sure that you avoid the common mistakes and do the right steps.

Do not do

1. Do not submit your URL to Google
2. Do not publish any content/article you have on site in any other place.
3. Do not put any affiliate link.
4. Do not put AdSense Code or any other PPC code.

Do

1. Put up to three pages (index page + 2 content pages) in the very simple html including basic on-page SEO like title tag, meta description tag and H1&H2 tags.
2. Use onlywire.com to save one of your content pages (see comment for elaboration).
3. Every 24 hours check if your new domain is indexed using the following command: site:www.yourdomain.com
4. Congratulation! Your new domain is indexed.
5. Now you can set up your site as you had in mind. My recommendation is to follow SEO guidance and to make your site for human use.
